Discussion:

This meeting provided a space for Geneva Dialogue participants to go around the 'digital circle' and provide updates on their work from the first half of 2021. Some projects included:

- Prototyping climate security early warning technology in communities.
- Participatory consultations to assess local climate security risks & develop cooperation opportunities.
- Building collaborations across UN agencies to continue to emphasize these topics among international policymakers and the UN Security Council.
- Translating research into action, pursuing the solutions that work.
- Understanding how identity based violence interacts with climate change and outlining the types of prevention strategies governments can adopt.
- Strengthening the role of traditional and local authorities in environmental peacemaking, while strengthening information sharing among mediation actors.
- Facilitating and training security sector actors, policymakers, journalists, activists, and civil society on water, peace, and security.
- Pursuing the creation of a new mandate around human rights and climate change at the Human Rights Council.
- Connecting work on the ground between climate, security, and health work.
- Creating pathways for students and young professionals to learn from professionals working in environment, climate, conflict, and peace.
